



HUNTING EXEMPTION: 2018

Hunting Rules and Regulations 2018

In the spirit of fair chase, the principal utilization of our natural resources will be adhered to:

1. No female wild animals with dependent off-spring or that may look pregnant may be hunted. If a pregnant animal is shot accidentally or purposefully, the hunter will be charged double the price for that respective animal. [Females can only be hunted during normal hunting season 1 May to 31st August
2. Know the capability of your equipment and your competence. Do not attempt to shoot an animal that is outside of your ability and /or equipment specifications.
3. When the hunter has released an arrow, inform the hunting guide or management immediately. Wait in the hide until the hunting guide/respective/coordinator arrive, after which the animal will be followed up.
4. A hunter who wounds an animal will be required to stop hunting and inform the hunting coordinator or management immediately. Remain in the hide. Should wounded animals be found by our staff/ guides/ trackers the animal will be killed and the incident reported
5. Animals, which are wounded and/ or lost will be charged for. The Hunting Coordinator/ Management's judgement is final as to whether an animal is wounded or not.
6. Strictly no shooting is permitted within 500m of any of the following vehicle, lodge, camp or buildings.
7. No hunting or shooting of birds and/or predators without written permission of management.
8. All equipment must be sighted at the range before hunting and the same equipment used for sighting is to be used for hunting.
9. Practice shots will be required before the hunt and will be managed by the hunting coordinator/Management.
10. No animal may be hunted that is not on the game quota. Animals shot that are not on the landowner's quota will be liable to a fine of 200% or the animal's replacement value.
11. Hunting may only be conducted in the presence of a guide or representative as decided by management.
12. If any additional service is required, contact hunting guide or management.
13. Guides/ Trackers/ Representatives are encouraged to report to any incidents of bribery and animals hunted or wounded where an attempt at bribery is involved will be charged for at double the going rate and guide tracker/ representative will be allowed to keep the bribe or present as his reward for reporting it to the management.
14. The management reserves the right to prohibit anyone hunting certain species of game if we believe his equipment is not capable of making clean kill.
15. Starting time for hunting in the morning and closing in the afternoon will be determined by the Hunting Coordinator or Management.
16. **Hunters are not permitted to hunt under the influence of alcohol.**
17. As trackers/ guides/ skimmers are required to render a full day's work, it is requested that you refrain from handing them alcohol at any time.
18. All tips or gifts for the trackers must be given to them in the presence of management.
19. It's the hunter's responsibility to make sure that his shot is a clear shot.
20. The final decision to shoot and animal rests with the hunter and not with the tracker/ guide or representative. Guides/ trackers/ representatives are not responsible for any mistakes.
21. All game remains the property of **Thabaledi Game Lodge** and may not be removed from the property until such time as it is paid for in full. All payment before departure – immediate EFT and/or debit/ credit cards are only accepted method of payment.
22. A permit to transport meat must be issued by **Management** before departure.
23. After settlement of full accommodation and hunting account an **Exit Permit** will be issued by **Management** before departure.
24. Right Admission is reserved.
